3. Detailed Achievement of Vision Objectives

3.1 "Multi-faculty Model College with a Multi-skill Curriculum"

- NEP 2020 Curricular Reforms:** In 2025–26, the college successfully implemented the 4-Year UG Honours framework with a Single Major and one Minor, offering multidisciplinary flexibility in line with the National Education Policy.

- **Futuristic Skill Integration:** The Boards of Studies extensively updated the curriculum to include cutting-edge Skill Enhancement Courses (SECs) such as Introduction to Artificial Intelligence, Applications of AI, Generative AI for OOP, Cyber Security, and Cloud Computing across B.A., B.Com., and B.Sc. programmes.
- **SCIM Skill Hub:** The dedicated Skill Hub actively organized offline training programmes, resulting in 77 students successfully completing certification in job roles such as Office Assistant and Assistant Computer Technician between June 2025 and January 2026.

3.2 "Practical Training at an Affordable Cost to the Downtrodden"

- **Experiential Learning:** The college mandated Community Service Projects (CSP) and extensive Short-Term/Semester Internships as part of the credit framework to ensure hands-on, practical training.
- **Start-up Mindset Training:** Partnering with the Wadhvani Foundation, 30 students successfully completed the "Start-up Mindset" basic level certification, equipping them with practical entrepreneurial skills at zero additional cost.
- **Scholarship Support for Downtrodden Students:** A total of 281 students received crucial financial assistance through government scholarships. The College Account processed scholarships for 213 students across ST, BC, EBC, Kapu, and minority backgrounds, while the Students Account facilitated scholarships for 68 SC category students.

3.3 "Bringing Out Hidden Talents and Making them Globally Preferred"

- **National-Level Student Representation:** Ms. Puppala Mounika was the only candidate from Government Degree Colleges selected for the prestigious Viksit Bharat Young Leaders Dialogue 2026 at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. She presented innovative digital solutions for empowering migrant workers at this forum organized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.
- **APPGCET Success:** The institution celebrated remarkable success in the AP Post-Graduate Common Entrance Test, where 20 students secured ranks below 1000, demonstrating strong academic outcomes.
- **Faculty Research Excellence:** Dr. I.V. Narayana published research on Fintech approaches for sustainable aquaculture. Multiple faculty members, including Dr. K. Nagabhusan Reddy and Smt. Ch. Devi Palaka, presented research on AI applications in life sciences at national and international conferences.

4. Detailed Achievement of Mission Objectives

4.1 "Quality Enhancement and Securing Better Employability"

- **Autonomous Status & Accreditation:** The institution operates under empowered Autonomous status granted by the UGC for a ten-year period (2024–25 to 2033–34). We proudly maintain NAAC 'A' Grade accreditation with a CGPA of 3.18.
- **Triple ISO Certifications:** Institutional quality is further standardized through three concurrent ISO certifications valid until December 2026: ISO 21001:2018/9001:2015 (Educational Organizations Management), ISO 14001:2015 (Environmental Management), and ISO 50001:2018 (Energy Management).
- **Campus Placements:** A notable recruitment drive in collaboration with Divis Laboratories on 3 June 2025 resulted in 11 students from B.Sc. and M.Sc. Chemistry programmes being successfully placed.
- **Financial Literacy Training:** Dr. I.V. Narayana coordinated a Financial Literacy Training Programme in collaboration with AMFI and IIM Visakhapatnam, bridging the gap between academic knowledge and practical financial management for 400 college students.

4.2 "Reducing the Urban-Rural Divide through Community-Oriented Training"

- **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA):** The college was officially recognized as a UBA partner institution, adopting five local villages—Mandapaka, Tetali, Komaravaram, Velpur, and Duwa—to actively identify local issues and propose developmental solutions.
- **Aqua Entrepreneurship Seminar:** Recognizing the agrarian/aquaculture-based economy of our rural district, the Department of Commerce hosted a two-day ICSSR-SRC sponsored National

Seminar on “Aqua Entrepreneurship: Opportunities and Challenges for Vikasith Andhra Pradesh,” connecting rural students with modern industry practices.

- **Republic Day in Adopted Villages:** UBA volunteers facilitated Republic Day flag-hoisting ceremonies in adopted villages, spreading the spirit of patriotism and national integration directly into rural communities.

4.3 "Inculcating Core Values of Life Among the Youth"

- **Constitutional & Democratic Values:** The college systematically celebrated Samvidhan Hatya Divas, National Constitution Day (Preamble Reading), National Vigilance Day (Integrity Pledge), and National Voters' Day (Voters' Pledge, rally, competitions) to instil democratic values and civic responsibility.
- **Ethics & Social Responsibility:** Activities such as the “Pedal for Freedom” cycling rally, anti-drug campaigns under Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan, the Social Justice lecture by Sri DVVS Varma, and the Youth for Social Impact orientation programme deeply embedded ethics and community responsibility.
- **Blood Donation – Caring Citizens:** The institution’s distinctive practice of “Cultivating Caring Citizens through Blood Donation” was rigorously upheld, with the Youth Red Cross, Red Ribbon Club, and NSS organizing major blood donation camps.
- **Environmental Values (Green AP):** The college maintained its “Green AP” commitment through continuous ISO 14001 and ISO 50001 certified practices, including the Tree Adoption programme, zero-waste initiative, Swachh Andhra Pledge, and Neeru-Meeru water conservation drives.
