DARWIN'S DAY

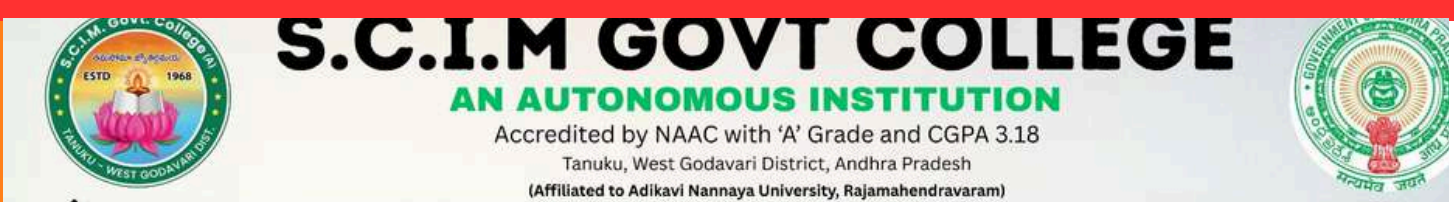

SOCIAL JUSTICE

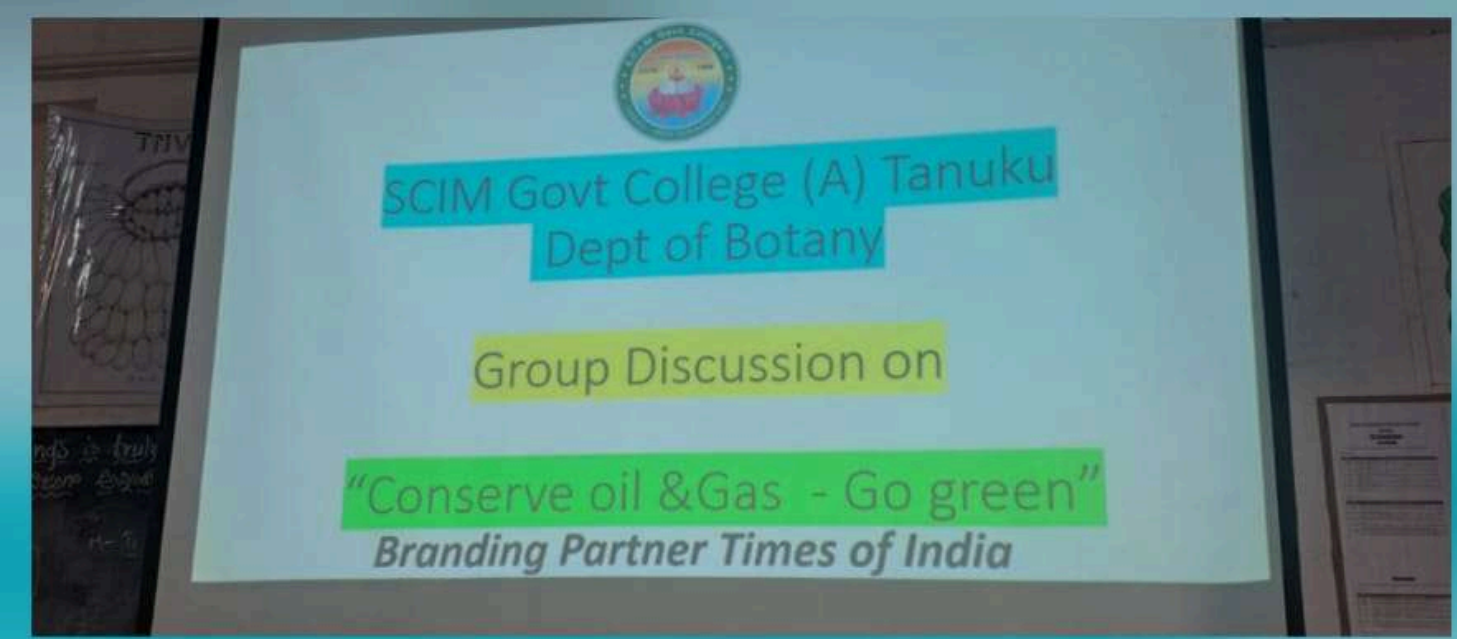

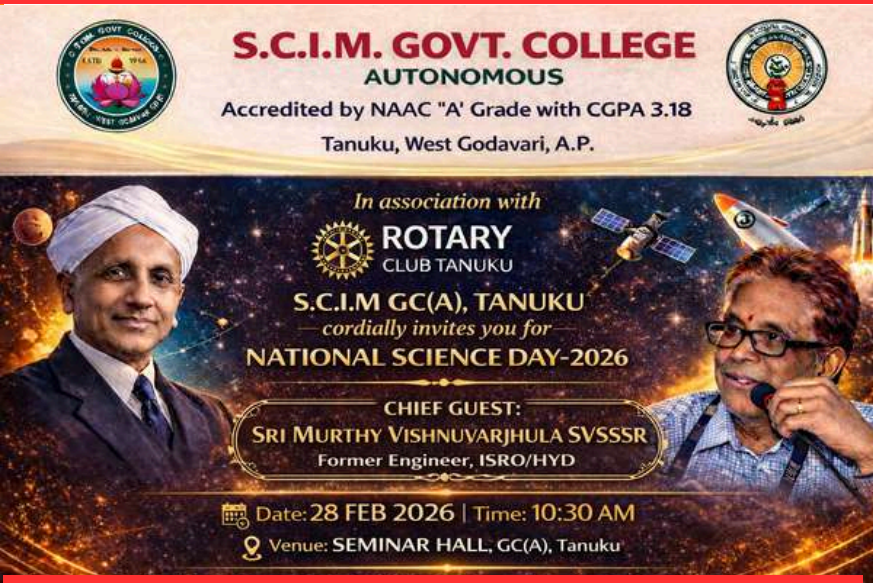
GO GREEN-CONSERVE OIL & GAS

AWARENESS ON ROAD SAFETY & FREE EYE CAMP

Road safety awareness was created for the students by the NSS wings of SCIM College. The program aimed to educate students about the importance of following traffic rules. NSS volunteers explained the need to wear helmets, use seat belts, and avoid using mobile phones while driving. They also informed students about the causes of road accidents and how they can be prevented. The awareness program encouraged students to become responsible road users. It helped students understand that road safety is an important part of protecting their own lives and the lives of others.



A free eye camp was organized for the students and staff of SCIM Government College, Tanuku in association with the Red Ribbon Club. The camp was conducted with the support of SRR Lions Eye Hospital to promote eye health and awareness. A team of experienced doctors and medical staff examined the eyesight of the participants. Students and staff members underwent free eye check-ups during the camp. The doctors provided guidance on maintaining proper eye care and preventing common eye problems.

Those who were found to have vision problems were advised appropriate treatment. Free spectacles were distributed to the participants who required them. The camp helped in identifying vision issues among many students at an early stage. The Red Ribbon Club volunteers assisted in organizing the camp and guiding the participants. The program concluded successfully with active participation from students and staff, promoting the importance of regular eye check-ups.

TRAINING PROGRAMS



The Skill Hub of SCIM Government College actively organized training programs to enhance the employability skills of students in different sectors. As part of this initiative, students were trained under various job roles such as Office Assistant in the Management sector and Assistant Computer Technician in the Electronics sector. Three batches successfully completed their training between June 2025 and January 2026. The first batch of Office Assistant training was conducted from 09-06-2025 to 03-09-2025, and 22 students received their course completion certificates. The second batch of Office Assistant training was held from 28-06-2025 to 15-09-2025, and 29 students were awarded certificates. The Assistant Computer Technician batch was conducted from 27-10-2025 to 24-01-2026, and 26 students received their certificates. In total, 77 students were distributed course completion certificates, marking the successful completion of their skill training at the Skill Hub of SCIM Government College.



S. C. I. M. Government College (A), Tanuku is actively promoting Artificial Intelligence awareness and skill development among its students and faculty through important academic initiatives. The college participated in a mandatory online Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Artificial Intelligence conducted from February 23 to March 13, 2026 by Andhra Pradesh Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (APCCE). 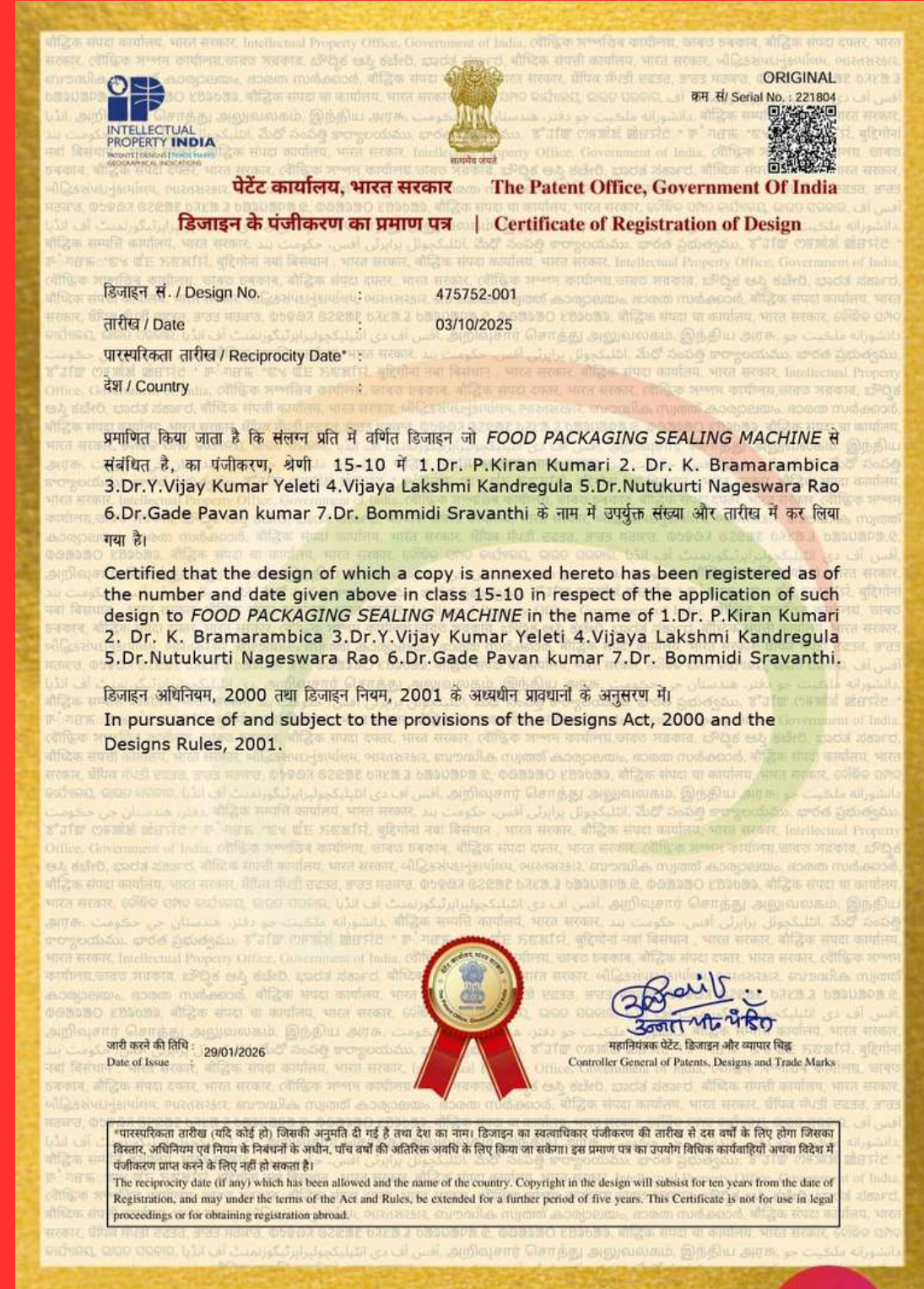
