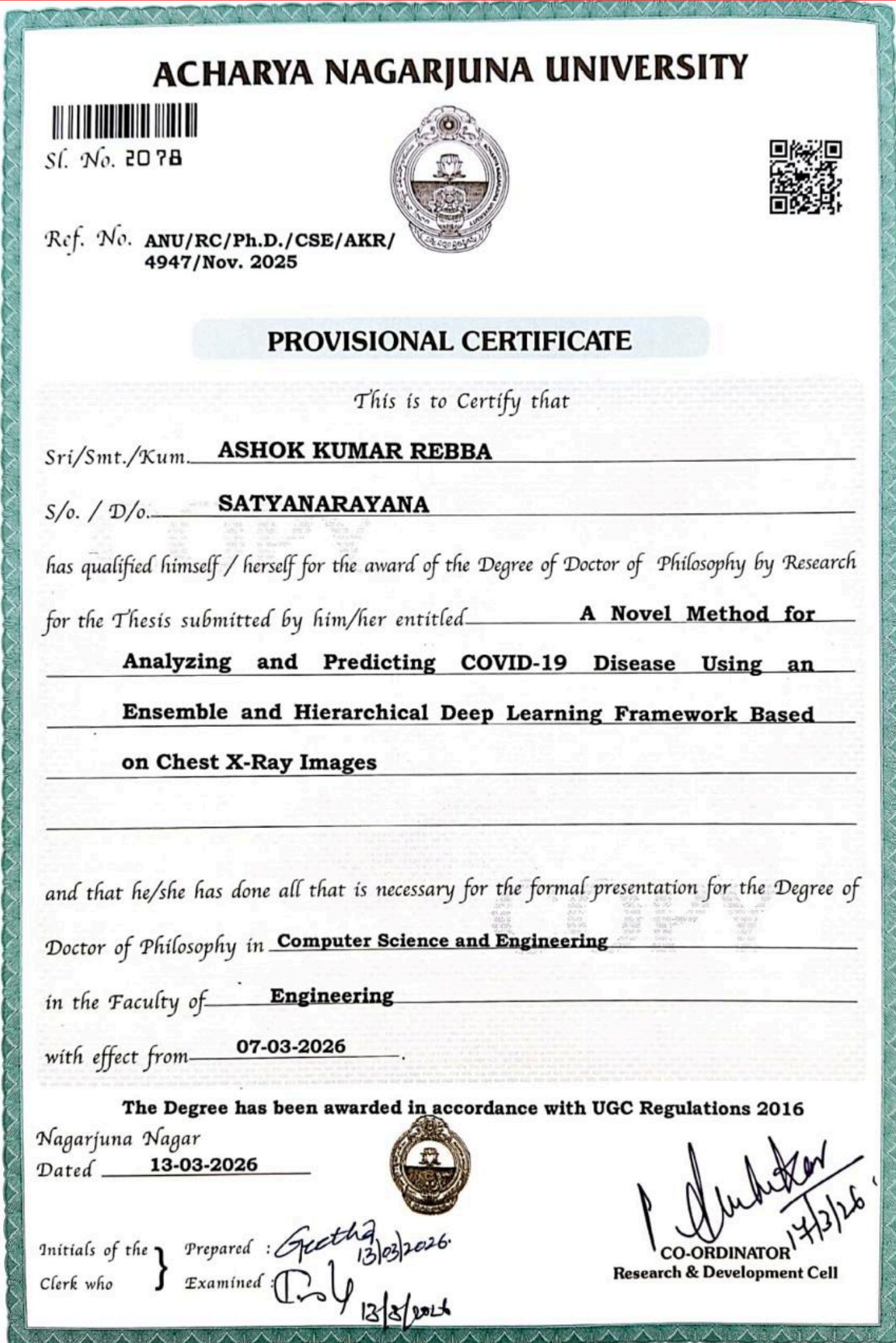

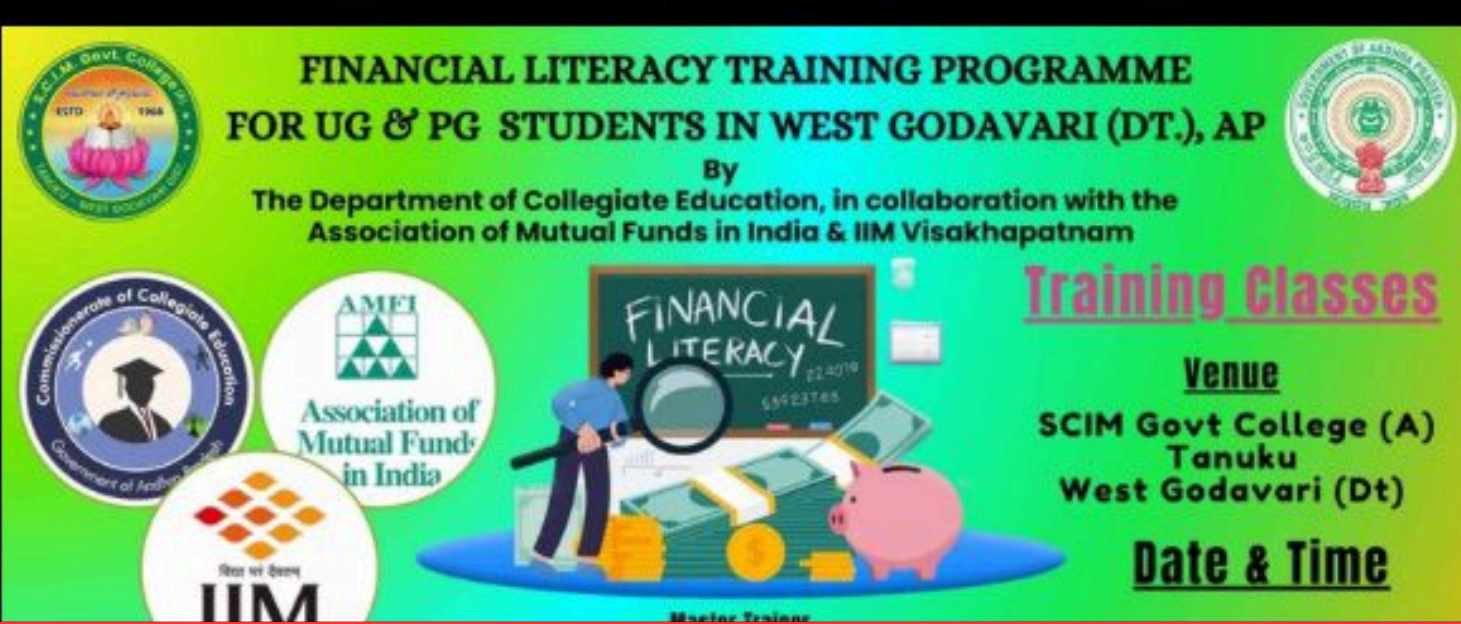

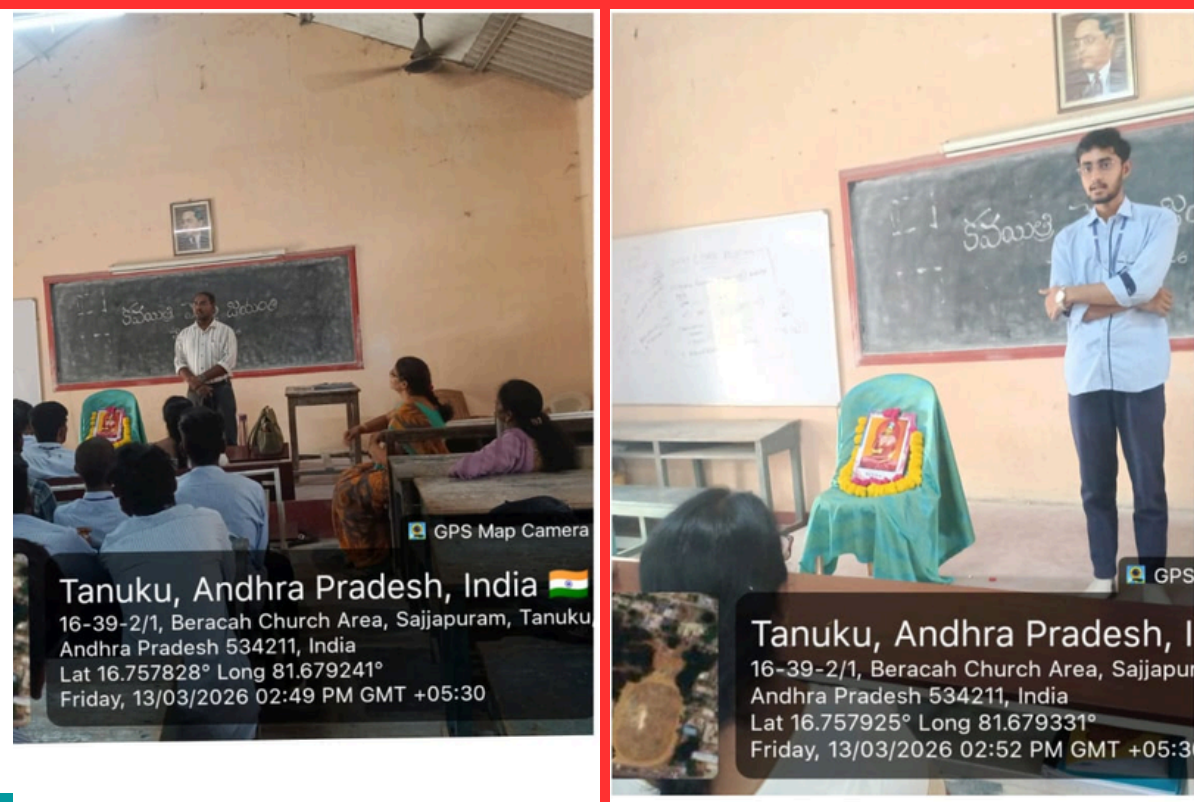

### Endemic and Threatened Species: Conservation Challenges and Strategic Interventions — A Review

#### Abstract

Endemic species represent unique evolutionary lineages and contribute disproportionately to global biodiversity; however, their restricted geographic ranges make them highly vulnerable to extinction. A large proportion of endemic taxa are currently classified as threatened due to accelerating anthropogenic pressures and environmental change. This review synthesizes peer-reviewed literature from Scopus-indexed journals to examine the major conservation challenges facing endemic and threatened species and to evaluate strategic interventions implemented across diverse ecosystems. The review highlights habitat loss and fragmentation, climate change, invasive alien species, overexploitation, and genetic erosion as the primary drivers of population decline and extinction risk. Patterns of endemism and threat status reveal that biodiversity hotspots and island ecosystems are particularly vulnerable, with plants, amphibians, and reptiles exhibiting high levels of endangerment. Current conservation strategies, including in situ and ex situ approaches, community-based conservation, policy frameworks, and emerging technological tools such as remote sensing, molecular techniques, and artificial intelligence, are critically assessed. While protected areas remain central to conservation efforts, their effectiveness depends on integrative management, stakeholder participation, and adaptive governance. The review further identifies key research gaps, including taxonomic and geographic biases, limited long-term monitoring, and inadequate integration of climate resilience into conservation planning. It concludes that conserving endemic and threatened species requires coordinated, interdisciplinary, and evidence-based interventions that align scientific innovation with policy implementation and local community engagement to ensure long-term biodiversity persistence.

### Ethnomedicinal Utilization of Tuberos Plants for the Treatment of Human Ailments in the Polavaram Area of West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh, India

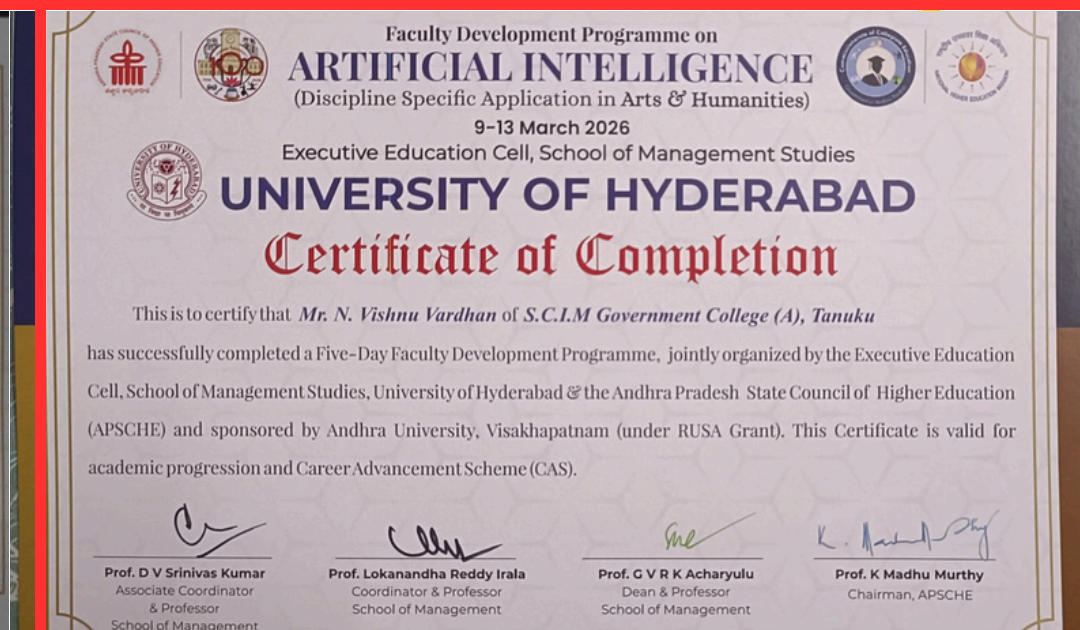
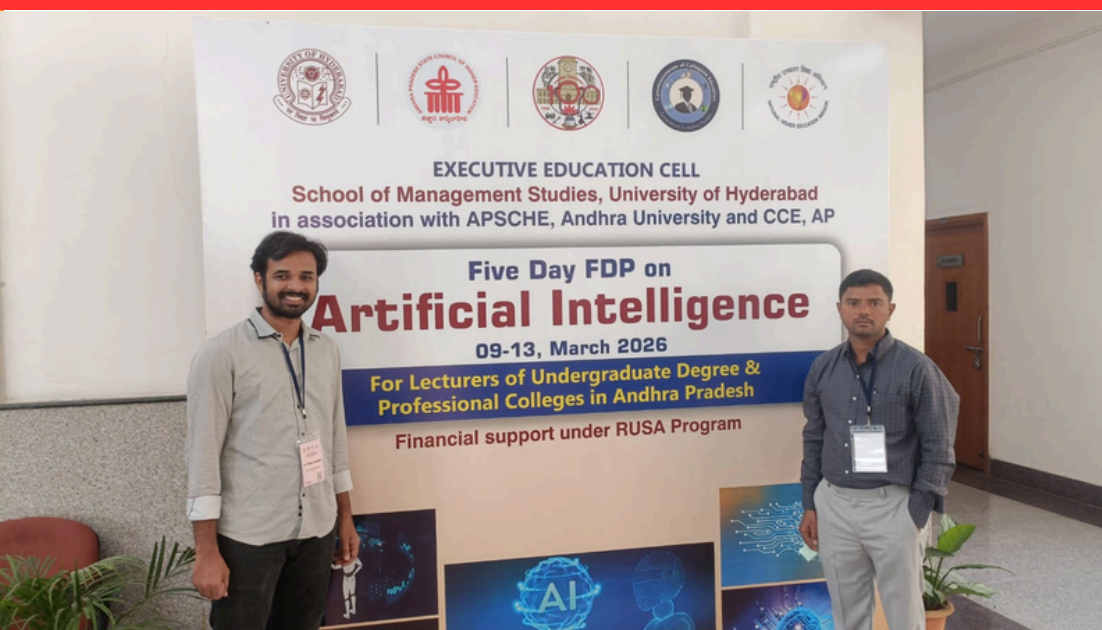

#### Abstract

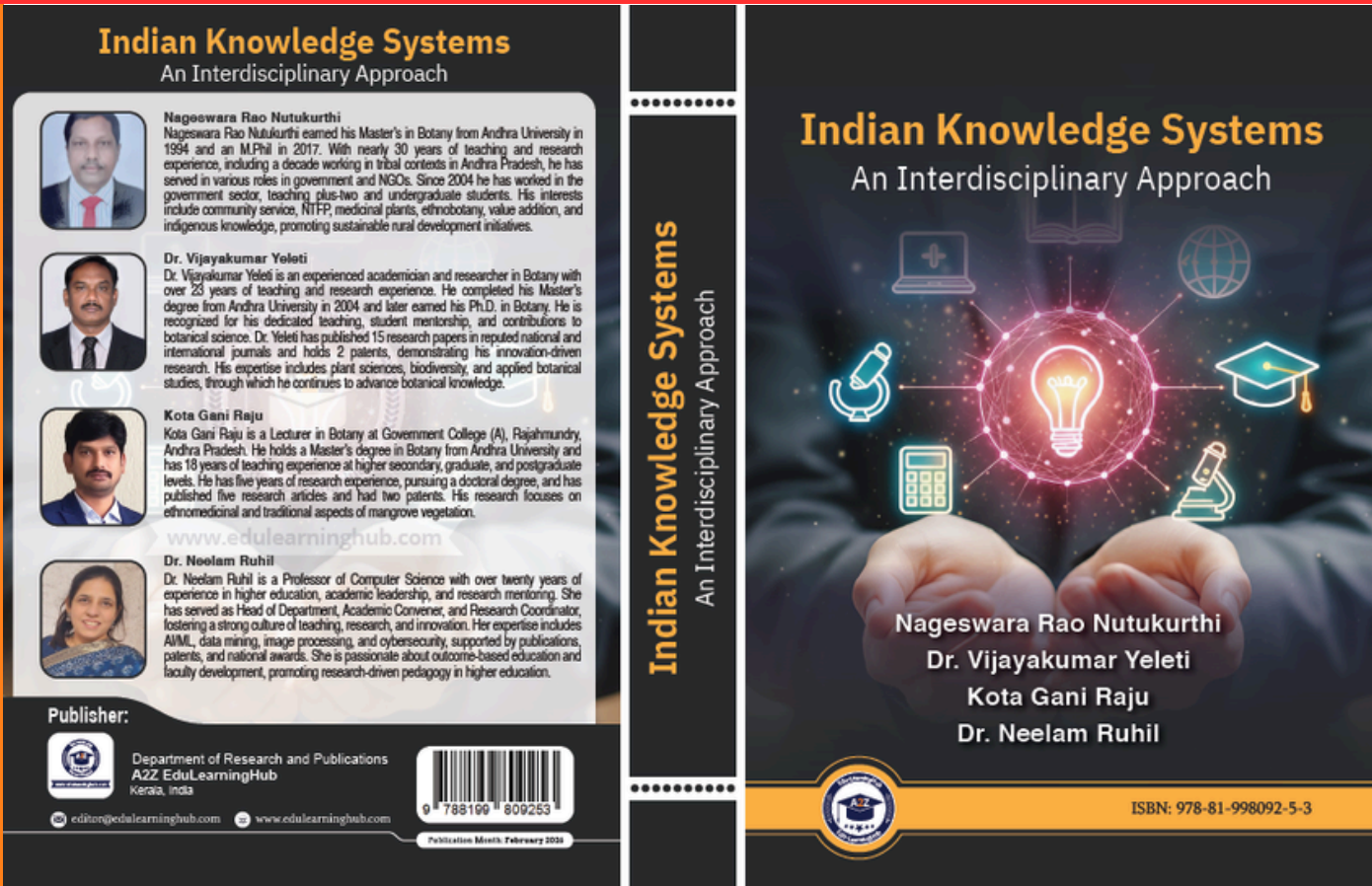
An ethnomedicinal survey was conducted in the Polavaram region of West Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh, India, to document the traditional utilization of tuberos medicinal plants by indigenous communities. Field investigations employing semi-structured interviews, guided field walks, and quantitative ethnobotanical indices recorded 14 tuberos species belonging to 10 families, representing 23 use-reports (UR). Family-wise analysis revealed the dominance of Dioscoreaceae (21.43%), followed by Liliaceae and Cucurbitaceae (14.29% each). Gastrointestinal disorders constituted the principal therapeutic category (34.78%), indicating a strong reliance on underground plant parts for digestive ailments. *Pueraria tuberosa* emerged as the most culturally significant species (5 UR; 21.74%), with reported applications in cough, rheumatism, nervous disorders, and skin diseases. Other frequently cited taxa included *Asparagus racemosus* and *Cyperus rotundus*. Comparative evaluation with earlier ethnobotanical and pharmacological studies supports the therapeutic relevance of these taxa. However, destructive harvesting of underground organs poses conservation challenges, necessitating sustainable management strategies and scientific validation. The study contributes region-specific quantitative data to the ethnomedicinal literature of Andhra Pradesh and underscores the importance of preserving indigenous knowledge systems.

Dr. Ch. Devi Palaka from the Department of Botany contributed a comprehensive review on endemic and threatened species, highlighting major conservation challenges and strategic interventions. Dr. Y. Vijaya Kumar also made a significant contribution through his research on the ethnomedicinal utilization of tuberos plants in the Polavaram region. Their studies emphasize the importance of biodiversity conservation, sustainable practices, and the preservation of indigenous knowledge systems. Both faculty members showcased the academic strength and research excellence of the institution on a global platform. Their work reflects a strong commitment to environmental awareness and scientific advancement. This achievement has enhanced the reputation of SCIM Government College in the field of research and higher education.

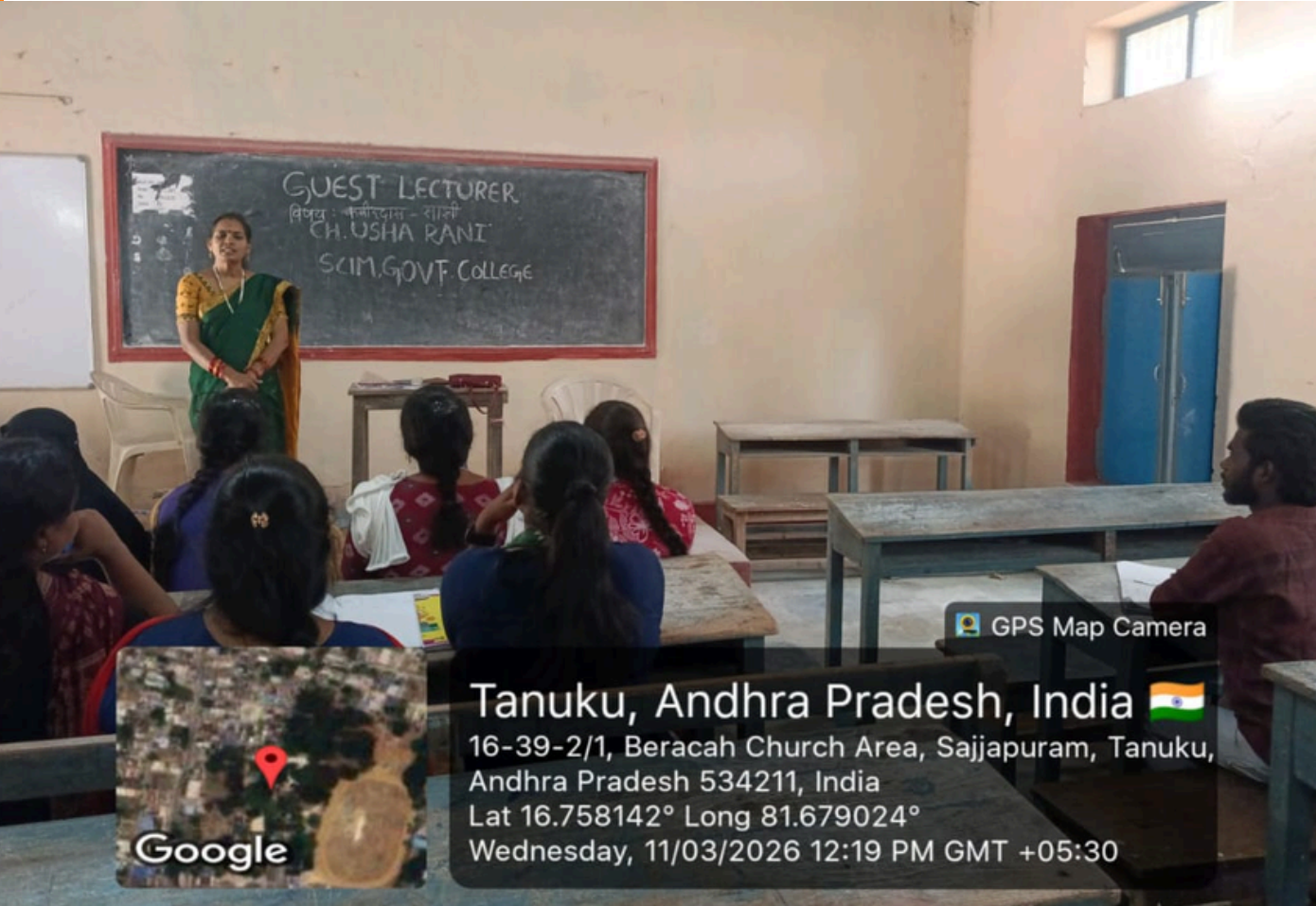

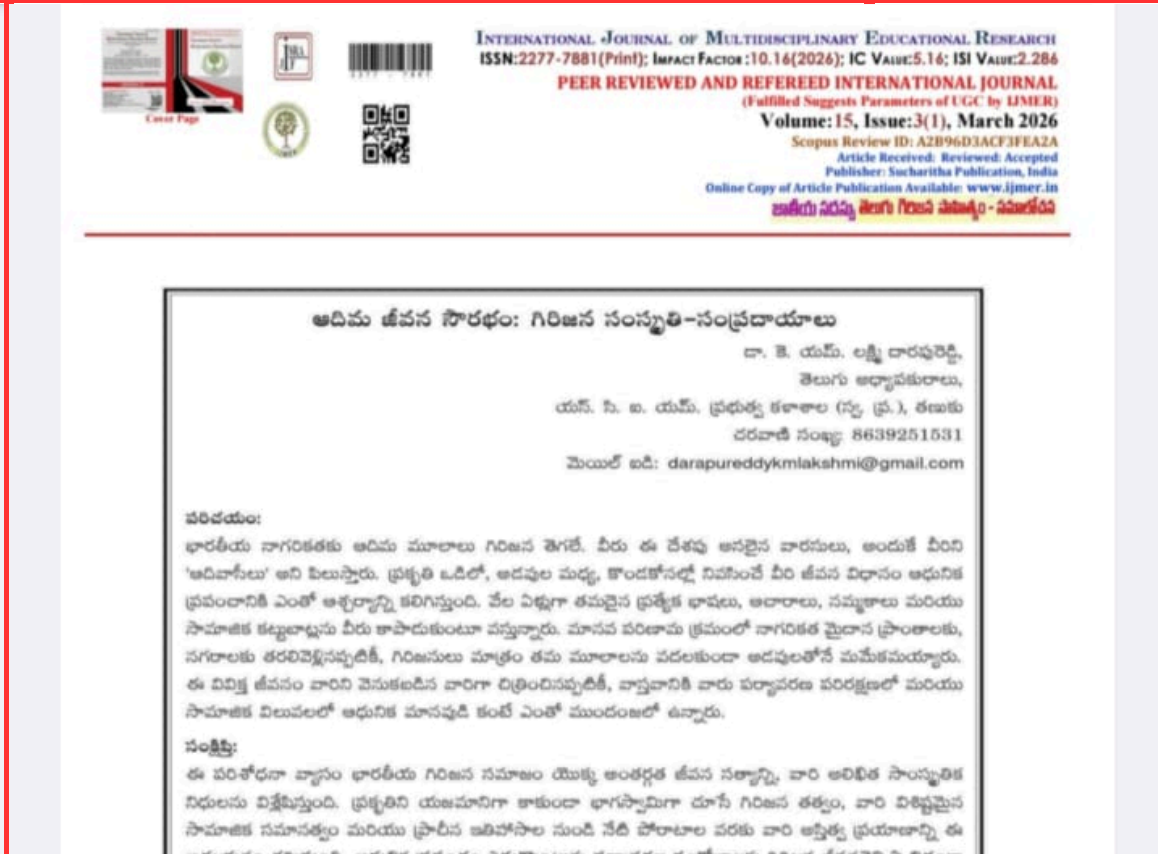


## ACHIEVEMENTS

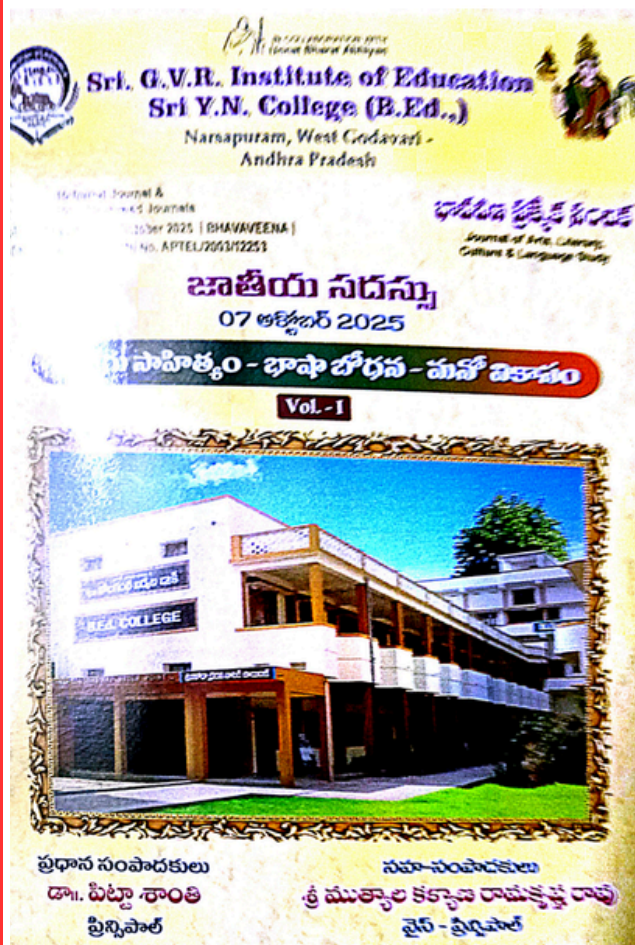
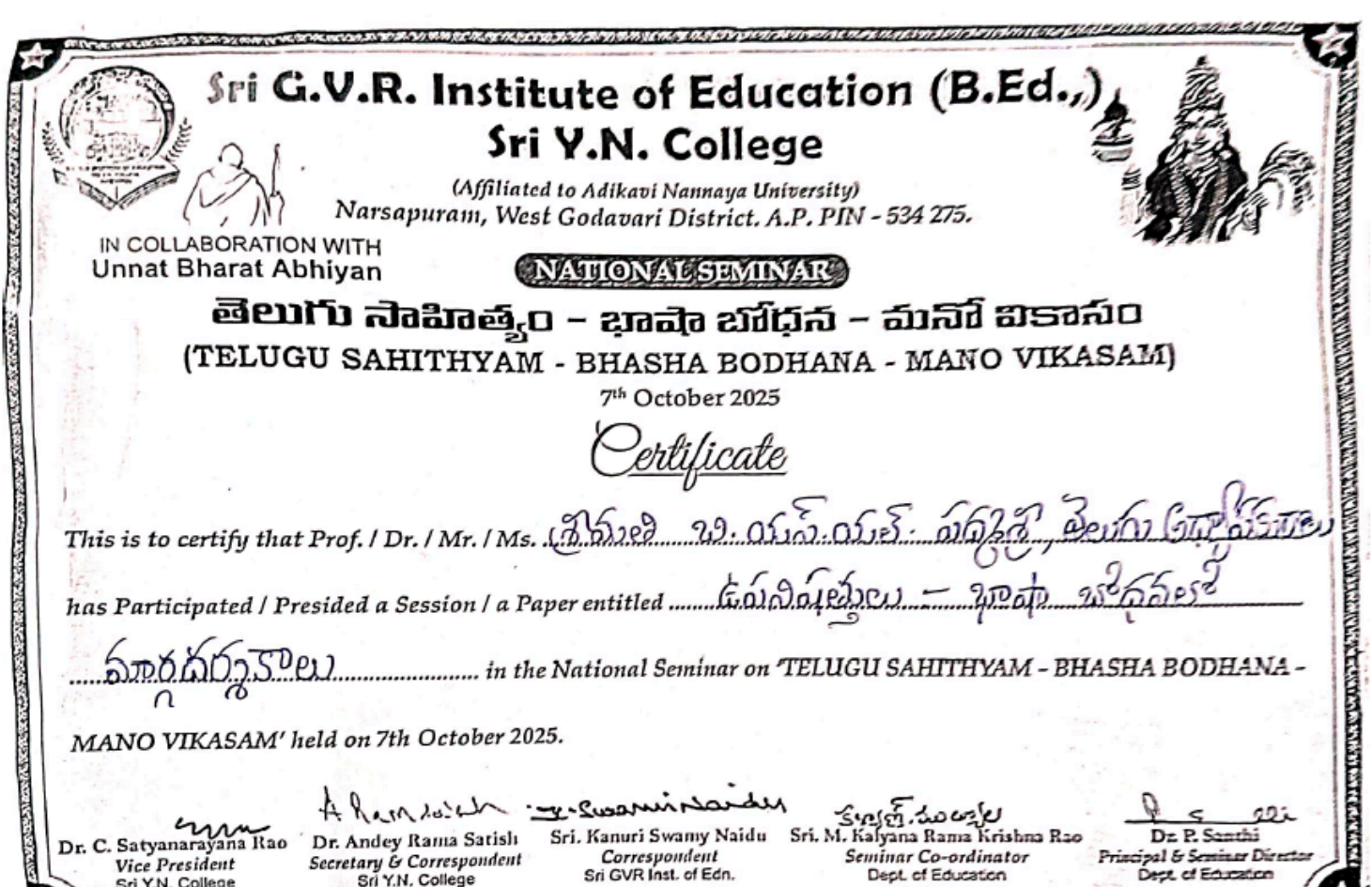
